

The Board of Zoning Appeals met on Tuesday, January 2, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Chairman James Pitts with the following members forming a quorum: Steve Porter, Lester Rhoads and James Thomas. Board Member Jill Timberlake was absent. Attorney Chris Byrd was present.

The first item on the agenda was the approval of the September 5, 2017 minutes. Steve Porter made a motion to approve the minutes with a second by Lester Rhoads. The motion passed 3-0. James Thomas abstained from the vote.

Chairman Pitts welcomed James Thomas to the Board of Zoning Appeals. On November 27, 2017 Mr. Thomas was appointed by the Town Council to complete Olivia Orme's term which expires on December 31, 2019.

The third item on the agenda was the election of officers for 2018. After a brief discussion, Steve Porter made a motion to retain the current Chairman and Vice Chairman for another year. The motion was seconded by Lester Rhoads and passed 4-0.

Executive Secretary, Carolyn Hofelich briefly reviewed the new Sign Ordinance 2017-7. She provided each member with a copy explaining the new ordinance voids Sign Ordinance 2013-1 and all subsequent amendments, or sign regulations within the Town of Corydon Zoning Ordinance dated 9/11/1955. She further stated permitting free-standing signage within the State's right-of way will now require permission from the IDOT.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Steve Porter made a motion to adjourn the meeting with a second by Lester Rhoads. The motion passed 4-0.
